DREAMGIRLS - Friday, November 1, 2019 at 11:00am OR 8:00pm

(Suggested ages: 13 & up) Full of onstage joy and backstage drama, DREAMGIRLS tells the rags-to-riches story of a 1960s Motown girl group and the triumphs and tribulations that come with fame and fortune.
