- We had several parents attend our Sycamore Training for Parents Workshop last Tuesday evening. We are working toward using our Sycamore Student Information System to the fullest extent possible, and this was an excellent opportunity for parents to become familiar with its capabilities and functionality. 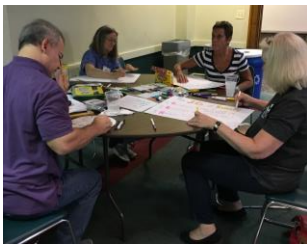
