- Registration for the 2017-18 school year opened last week through Sycamore as Mr. Reed and Mrs. Stubblefield updated the online enrollment portal at <a href="https://app.sycamoreschool.com/admissions/index.php?schoolid=2494">https://app.sycamoreschool.com/admissions/index.php?schoolid=2494</a>. Re-enrollment at this time allows you to reserve your child's place in his/her class for the coming school year and allows us to plan our budget. We are receiving inquiries from prospective families daily, so early registration is strongly recommended. The \$50/per student non-refundable registration fee is payable through Sycamore's Pay Junction. No credit card information will be stored. eCheck (ACH withdrawal) payment is also available. Registration is not considered complete until the payment is made. All families who complete registration with payment by Tuesday, January 31<sup>st</sup> will be rewarded with FREE DRESS FRIDAYS for the month of February!
- Application for Tuition Assistance for K-8<sup>th</sup> grade is now open online at <a href="https://online.factsmgt.com/aid">https://online.factsmgt.com/aid</a>. Our school has a variety of financial aid opportunities available through the Catholic Education Foundation, Jochum Foundation, School Choice, the Archdiocese and Parish, Ulmer Foundation, and Community Catholic Center. The online application is used for all of these sources. The Jochum Scholarship has an additional paper application which can be downloaded here. Applications must be submitted online completely by March 15<sup>th</sup>. Parents will be notified of award amounts by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Please see the email sent on January 13<sup>th</sup>.
