SUPPORTING LIFELONG SCHOLARS

- It's cold and flu season; we've had some confirmed cases of the flu, stomach bugs, and common cold symptoms. Just a reminder, if Mrs. Stubblefield or your child's teacher has called you to pick up your child from school because he/she is sick, your child must stay home the next day. Page 13 of the handbook states that your child must be fever and/or symptom-free for 24 hours before they can come back to school.
 - According to the CDC (Center for Disease Control), the following are signs and symptoms of having the flu: "fever and/or chills, cough, sore throat, a runny and/or stuffed nose, body aches, headaches, and fatigue (flu symptoms may present in groups of two or three or all at once). Some flu patients also experience diarrhea and vomiting."



- We are being extra vigilant about ensuring that students are washing hands, not sharing food/drink, using good
 hygiene when coughing/sneezing, and taking water bottles home daily to be washed. Please remind them as well.
 Also, we are frequently washing desks/tables, doorknobs, locker handles, water fountains, etc. Thank you for
 helping us help you keep your children and our staff well!
